Prior to bringing your car to the track, inspect each item on the car as noted on this Tech Sheet.

It is YOUR responsibility to bring a safe and well-maintained car to the event.

Consult a certified mechanic or event tech inspector if you have any questions.

- A full-size, street legal windshield. No cracks. Must be clean and free of obstructive decals/graphics
- Targa or T-top vehicles must either bolt the removable panels in place or removed entirely.
- Car Number on each side of Car visible to Corner Workers – Track can provide.
- Convertibles must run with the top lowered and safely stowed. Weather Permitting
- Brake fluid -Less than 6 months old, reservoir full. (Fluid should be light in color)
- Brake Hoses and Lines -Dry and in good condition
- Brake Pads – 3/8" thickness or greater. Fresh/new brake pads recommended.
- Brake Rotors – Must be free of cracks and/or excessively deep grooves.
- Brake Lights - Fully functioning (all)
- Battery - Securely fastened and good condition, no leaks corrosion or exposed
- Battery terminals. Be sure Positive Terminal is covered and protected
- Engine, Radiator and Transmission - No fluid leaks, radiator overflow tanks secure.
- Reliable throttle return springs, no binding, returns freely.
- Exhaust – Good physical condition, securely mounted.
- Front Suspension -No looseness permitted. Bearings and joints in excellent condition.
- Rear Suspension - Drive train & components in excellent condition. Suspensions secure.
- Wheels - No cracks or bends. Lug nuts torque checked after each session. No hubcaps or trim rings.
- Tires - Good condition. No cracks, bulges, flat spot or cord. Minimum 2/32" tread
- Mirrors -At least 2 securely mounted rear-view mirrors
- Video camera / data devices MUST be secure. All loose items inside and outside car must be removed
- Driver and passenger windows to be fully open during on-track driving
- Headlights (if so equipped from the factory) should be in working order
- At a minimum, a factory 3-point system must be in place. Competition style 5- or 6-point systems are highly recommended. (check those certification date labels!)
- OPTIONAL: Fire Extinguisher -2.5 lbs. minimum, ABC rated, securely mounted within easy reach of the driver.
- Snell SA2015 or SA2020 helmets ONLY! (**M- or DOT-rated helmets are NOT ALLOWED**)
- Driver Attire: Long pants, long-sleeve shirt and closed-toe shoes are required of all drivers and passengers (in sessions allowing such)
- Full Driving Suits are recommended. This includes suit, gloves, socks & head sock/balaclava
- **I have inspected the above vehicle and take full responsibility for its condition on the track**
