## Thursday

Thursday is a practice day. Arrive early and have one extra day on track to refine your driving prior to the start of timed laps on Friday! Meals not included on Thursday. Track time begins at 9:00am and will end at 4:00pm.

Official Tech Inspection for drivers arriving later Thursday will begin at 4:00 through 7:00 pm in the Race port (East side).

Check-in opens in the Clubhouse at 1:00 pm and ends at 5:00 pm. If you are later than 5:00 pm, you must contact Kenady and check in with her first thing on Friday morning.

Stickers will be given Thursday during registration.

## A HOT LAP at MPH

### Turn 1 - Medium Apex

Heading down the front straight, position your car to the right side of the track. Do all of your braking prior to the turn in point of Medium Apex Turn 1. Exit Turn 1 using as much track as needed and then quickly work your way to the far-left side of the track in preparation for Late Apex Turn 2.

### Turn 2 - Late Apex

Watch for cars entering the track on your left!!! Turn 2 is a decreasing radius sweeper that requires a Late Apex. Stay wide, but do not cross over the Track Entry Lane that merges with traffic. Look far ahead for the late apex and make your turn in. Let the car exit to the far left side of the track and follow the two kinks along the East straight as you approach the fast Medium Apex Turn 3.

### Turn 3 - Medium Apex

Stay to the far left side of the track as you approach Turn 3. Tap the breaks lightly if needed then turn into Medium Apex Turn 3. This is a high speed turn that makes this section of the track the fastest section.

### Turn 4 - Medium Apex

After exiting Turn 3, stay to the left side of the track and look ahead for the hard breaking zone, just before your turn into Medium Apex Turn 4. Exit Turn 4 on the left side of the track in preparation for right hand Medium Apex Turn 5.

### Turn 5 - Medium Apex

Turn 5 should be considered a combination turn along with Medium/Late Apex Turn 6, as you can almost set your steering and drive through both corners very smoothly.

#### Turn 6 - Medium/Late Apex

When you exit Turn 6, use all of the available track to carry as much speed as safely possible, as the next section of track (from Turn 6 to Turn 9) is the second fastest section of the course. As you exit Turn 6, stay left and look for Early apex Turn 7.

#### Turn 7 - Early Apex

Turn 7 can be considered a kink rather than a turn, but you must stay close to the left edge of the track and hit the apex early, then let the car out to the far right side of the track and get ready for the quickly approaching Medium Apex Turn 8.

#### Turn 8 - Medium Apex

Prior to the turn in point of Medium Apex Turn 8, it is difficult to see the exit point, but it is very wide and you will need to use all of the track in order to carry your maximum speed safely through Turn 8.

#### Turn 9 - No Apex

Stay right following your exit of Turn 8 and then move slowly towards the center of the track in preparation for NO Apex Turn 9. Follow left Turn 9 through the middle of the track and then look far ahead for the Exit point and turn in point of Late Apex Turn 10.

### Turn 10 - Late Apex

After a few laps through Turns 9 & 10, you will consider them as a combination turn. If Turn 9 is done correctly, you will end up in the perfect position on the left side of the track when entering Turn 10.

### Turn 11 - Late Apex

Stay far left after exiting Turn 10 and look for your braking zone as you approach Late Apex Turn 11. You should have done all of your necessary braking prior to the turn in point, so that you can be smoothly back on the gas before the apex. Exit Turn 11 keeping the car close to the right side of the track as you approach Medium Apex Turn 12.

### Turn 12 - Medium Apex

Turn 12 comes up immediately as you exit Turn 11. Smoothly turn in and let the car exit out of the turn towards the right side of the track, just enough to keep the car from drifting, as Late Apex Turn 13 approaches very quickly and you will need to get your car over to the far left side of the track prior to the braking zone.

### Turn 13 - Late Apex

Turn 13 is a mini decreasing radius sweeper. Stay wide as you enter the turn and look far enough ahead for the Apex and its relationship to the track width at the exit point. This is an awkward, yet important turn, that leads to the front straight and one of the Passing Zones. As you exit Turn 13, move over to the right side of the track and let faster cars pass you.

#### GENERAL NOTE OF CAUTION:

When driving an unfamiliar track for the first few times, always enter each turn on the SLOW- side of fast and on the LATE-side of early. In other words, learn the correct driving line for your car and your experience by erring on the Safe-side of disaster. This is the safer approach, that is much more fun and a lot less embarrassing.
















# TRAFFIC FLOW

# **Points and Trophies**

You will have the opportunity to win one of 34 trophies during the weekend. Trophies will be awarded for best Short Track time in your class and best lap time in your class. All trophies will be awarded at Saturday Evening's Banquet.

### CLASSIFICATIONS.

- **Comp Coupe** All Comp Coupes will be in this class.
- **Racecar** Any car with a roll cage will be in this class.
- **GEN I III III –** All GEN I, GEN II, and GEN III cars that don't fall into Comp Coupe or Racecar class.
- **GEN IV** All GEN IV cars that don't fall into Comp Coupe or Racecar class.
- **GEN V** All GEN V cars that don't fall into Comp Coupe or Racecar class.

### Short track trophies

- Make sure you have your transponder in your car for Saturday afternoon's Short Track.
- Trophies will be awarded for 1st-3rd placing for each class in the Short Track.
- This will be based on your best run.
- Tie breakers will go to the drivers' second fastest laps.

### Viper Rendezvous - General Rules at MPH

### Paddock and Pit areas

- Share the space with your neighbors be courteous and considerate.
- Please put wood blocks under trailer tires and tongue jacks.
- NO DRILLING holes or hammering stakes into the asphalt surface to anchor canopies or awnings.
- Paddock Speed limit: 10 MPH.
- Keep your eyes open for spectators and pedestrians.
- Clean up / report oil and gas spills we have oil dry!
- Place trash in blue garbage cans
- Used oil and brake fluid may be disposed of in the "Used Oil" container (located between the two large white storage containers) which are located east of the restroom/shower building.
- No standing on wooden picnic tabletops
- Note location of Fire Extinguishers (hanging on support poles under the Race Port)
- Use jackstands when working under a vehicle.

### **On Track Behavior**

- Respect your fellow drivers.
- Watch your mirrors.
- All drivers are required to wear long-pants, long-sleeve shirt, closed-toe shoes and an SA2015 or SA2020 helmet. Head & neck restraints are encouraged. Full driving suits are encouraged, especially for drivers of highly modified and fully prepared race cars.
- Know where the passing zones are; use proper point-bys; passing on LEFT ONLY !!
- Do not cross the Pit Exit blend line when entering the track.
- Acknowledge ALL flags displayed by corner workers.
- Pit road speed: 35 MPH
- **STAY ON THE TRACK**. Our "four-wheels off" policy is as follows:
  - $\circ$  1<sup>st</sup> offense: report to pit road/black flag station for car inspection 1<sup>st</sup> WARNING.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> offense: report to pit road/black flag station for car inspection driver can be asked to park it / retire to the paddock for that session.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> offense: report to pit road/black flag station for car inspection driver can be asked to park it / retire for the DAY.

### **Passenger Sessions**

- For drivers in "good standing" for the day with regards to on-track behavior, we will have "ride-along / passenger" sessions scheduled for the last two run groups of the day.
- Drivers giving passenger rides are REQUIRED to drive at 7/10<sup>th</sup> and are expected to obey every flag and passing zone rules as well as keep their cars under control and ON THE TRACK during their ride-alongs.
- Failure to observe the rules above and/or a lack of "common sense" when giving passenger rides will result in the loss of passenger privileges for the remainder of the event.


